

GUIDELINES FOR GROUP TOURS

Thank you for bringing your group to visit Lollypop Farm! Please remember that the animals that are here are looking for a new home and that the shelter environment can be stressful to some pets. For the safety of all humans and animals, we ask that your group:

- **Uses inside voices** (indoors and outside on the farm). Loud noises can be especially scary to some of the animals both in the shelter and on the farm.
- Walking, <u>no running</u>. Especially while your group is visit the farm area, please ensure that everyone is walking. Running and fast movements are frightening to many farm animals.
- **Do not feed any of the animals**. Many of the pets here have special diets and could get sick if they eat something they should not.
- **Do not stick fingers in cages**. Some of the pets could have contagious zoonotic diseases or they could bite/scratch if they are scared.
- Do not climb on fences, statues, or agility equipment.
- Pay attention to posted signage and be aware of your surroundings.

PRO TIPS:

- There is a pavilion located on the south side of Lollypop Farm property. If you use this space, please be sure to clean up after you are done.
- The Town of Egypt Park has an awesome playground, kickball field, pavilion, and public restrooms. There is a footbridge that connects to the farm walk!
